These kinds of things go in the garbage cart.

Plastic:

Styrofoam & packing peanuts*



Styrofoam bakery & meat trays



Styrofoam take-out containers

Styrofoam cups



Caps & lids (under 3 inches)

Candy wrappers & chip bags



Plastic plates & utensils

Plastic clothes hangers



Empty motor oil & antifreeze containers

Empty prescription vials

Paper:

Food-soiled frozen food boxes



Disposable diapers



Ribbons or foil type wrapping paper

Wax & plastic-coated cardboard



Dirty or soiled paper & facial tissue

Hardback books*



**Tip: remove covers and binding for garbage (pages are recyclable)*

Glass:

Mirrors & window glass



Ceramics & dishes



Broken glass



Incandescent & halogen light bulbs only
(no fluorescent tubes or bulbs)

Metal:

Caps, rings & lids (under 3 inches)



Empty aerosol spray cans

Oil containers



Paint containers



Metal clothes hangers



Sharp or greasy metal



Alkaline batteries*



Miscellaneous:

Double bagged pet waste & litter

CDs & CD cases

WEIGHT LIMITS:

Garbage rates are based on container size.

1 - 13 gallon can, 20 lb wt limit;

1 - 20 gallon can, 30 lb wt limit;

1 - 32 gallon can, 60 lb wt limit;

1 - 45 gallon can, 80 lb wt limit;

1 - 64 gallon cart,120 lb wt limit;

1 - 96 gallon cart,180 lb wt limit
